Christopher Hubbard currently resides in Cincinnati, Ohio, where he enjoys a diverse teaching career. He is professor of guitar at Sinclair Community College and Cincinnati Christian University, and maintains a busy private studio with McCutcheon Music in Centerville. He was the founding president of the Greater Cincinnati Guitar Society, and continues to be active on its board of trustees. Mr. Hubbard received his Masters in Guitar Performance from Marshall University in 2000, where he held a teaching assistantship and was awarded the Shirley Turley performance award. He holds a Bachelors degree in guitar performance from Florida State University, where he studied under renowned pedagogue Bruce Holzman.

Kevin Mulhall holds a Master of Fine Arts degree in guitar performance from the State University of New York at Purchase and a Bachelor of Music in Musicology from Wright State University, Dayton Ohio. He is on the music faculty of Antioch University and Sinclair Community College. Along with frequent appearances in the Dayton area, he has performed widely in Japan, including radio and television appearances for the Nagasaki Broadcasting Corp., Kobe and Osaka guitar societies, and the Morioka and Masuda music schools. Mr. Mulhall has a strong interest in new and contemporary music and is a founding member of the Janus Collective, a chamber group focusing on 20th and 21st century repertoires.
